Quantum Imaging Ltd chooses Coventry as its new home

Quantum Imaging Ltd, an exciting medical device company looking to revolutionise the way the NHS diagnoses patients presenting at A&E with chest pain, has chosen Coventry for its new Head Quarters.

The company opened its purpose-designed commercial and development facility in the heart of the city in February 2016. It is currently recruiting locally and hopes to bring a range of new roles to the area as the company grows.

Vitalscan can be used in hospital A&E departments directly at a patient's bedside and produces highly accurate 2D imaging maps of the patient's heart.

The company's first area of development is the rapid triage of patients presenting in the Emergency Department with chest pain.
